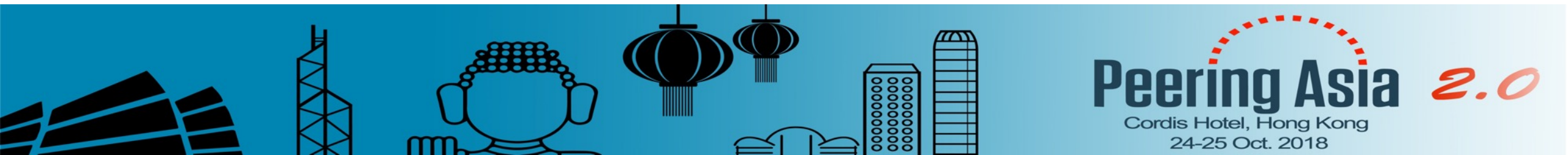


Peering Asia 2.0 at Hong Kong

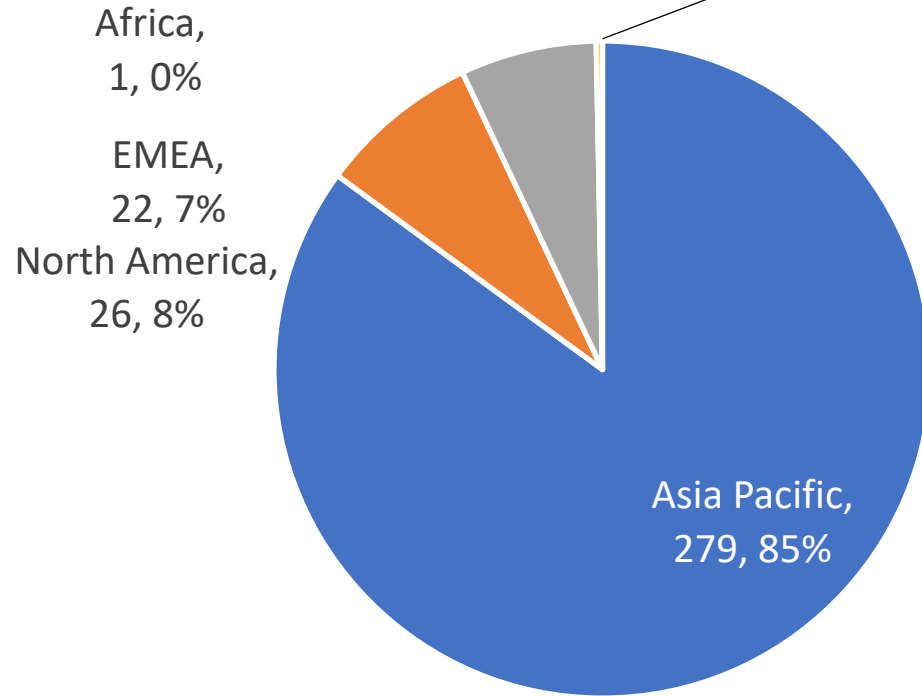

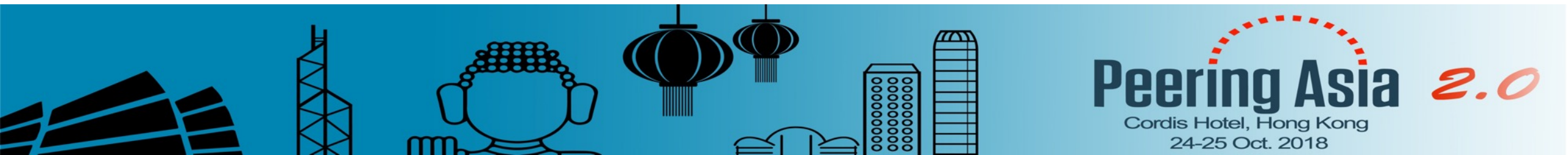
Both ASN and attendees increased

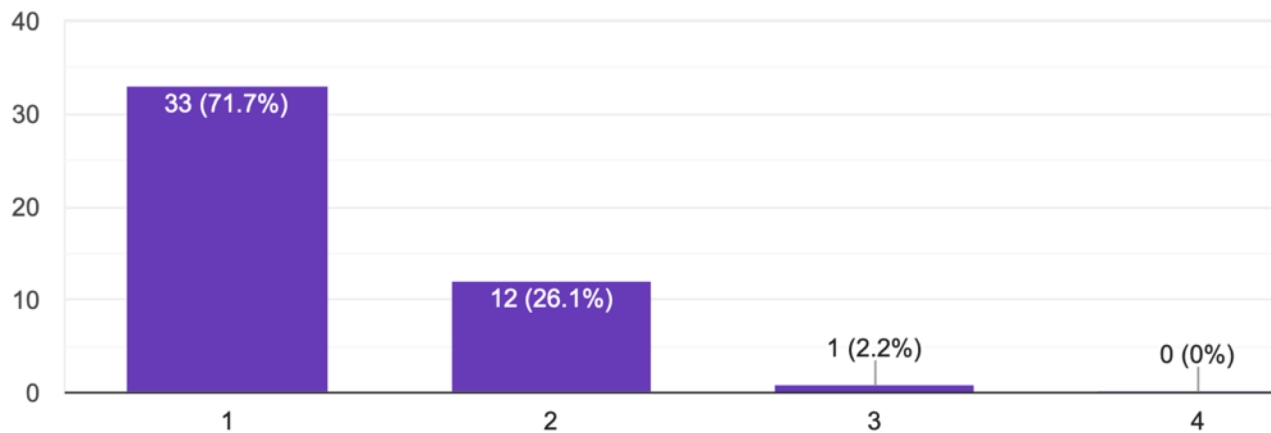

What is your overall evaluation of the Peering Asia 2.0?

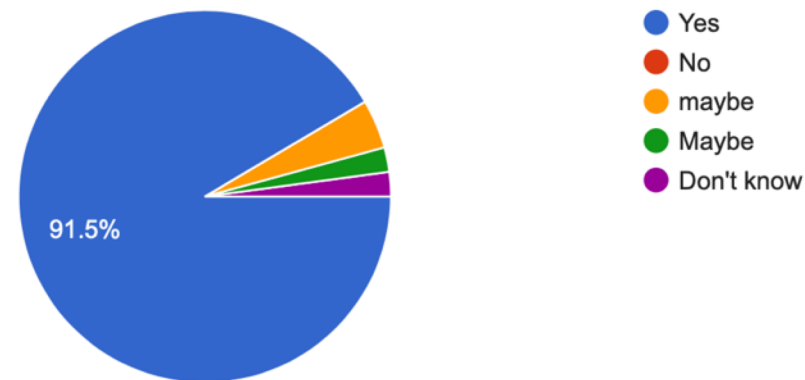
