

The experience that he and we as a team have gained in the first days and weeks, we would like to apply here and also help the colleagues from sdNOG and the Sudanese Network Engineers.

This is a different continent and also a different political situation. For this reason, it is not possible to simply drive across the border with a truck full of switches.

Currently there are intensive talks in the direction of the UN, WHO and the Red Cross. The goal is to use the current supply chains to bring donated equipment into the country.
